## Environmentally Speaking With Brett Motum

The Lake water level at the Easter outing was still up over 600mm one month after the rain event and is perhaps an effect of the reduced outflow at Corrie Creek due to the sanding up of this original Myall River mouth.

Prickly weed has also proliferated and is growing in huge banks where normally only "Possum Tail" weed is present.

Another noticeable effect (perhaps a desired one) is the apparent die-back of Lantana in these still submerged areas. One would like to think this was permanent but it is a very resilient weed and continues to encroach unchecked on the native vegetation.

The fishing was very limited due to the extensive areas of "Prickly Weed" but the writer

managed to land this 40cm "Yellow fin Bream" after an exciting battle on light gear.
